

**BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF JACKSON COUNTY, KANSAS**

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-21

A Resolution of the governing body of Jackson County, Kansas authorizing the levying of a Four-tenth percent (.4%) countywide retailer's sale tax and related matters.

ON THIS 24th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2012, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JACKSON COUNTY, KANSAS, are duly assembled at a regular meeting of such County Commissioners for the purpose of transacting business on behalf of Jackson County, Kansas and the general welfare and supervision of county employees.

WHEREAS, by previous Resolution of the governing body of Jackson County, Kansas (the "County"), the governing body authorized and provided for a special election question in the County for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the County the question of imposing a four-tenth percent (.4%) countywide retailer's sales tax for the purpose of financing public infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, an election was held in the County on August 7, 2012, at which time there was submitted to the qualified electors of the County the Sales Tax Proposition, and a majority of the qualified electors of the County voting on this proposition voted in favor thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act and the results of the aforementioned special election question, the governing body deems it necessary and advisable to authorize the levy of the Sales Tax and pledge the revenue received therefrom to the payment of financing public infrastructure projects, the proceeds of which will be used to finance public infrastructure project costs.

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF JACKSON COUNTY, KANSAS,

SECTION 1. The levy of a four-tenth percent (.4%) Countywide Retailers' Sales Tax is hereby authorized, with collection of the Sales Tax to commence in accordance with K.S.A. 12-191 on January 1, 2013.



SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the governing body.



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
