

RESOLUTION NO. 2013- 10

A Resolution levying and collecting a biennial occupation or license tax fee to public places where alcoholic liquor by the individual drink is sold

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas, meeting in a regular session on this 8th day of April, 2013, does hereby resolve as follows, to-wit:


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas has reviewed and adopted Resolution No. 2004-14 whereby alcoholic liquor by the individual drink in Jackson County, Kansas is allowed in places where at least 30% of the gross receipts are from sales of food for consumption on the premises and prohibited in all other public places.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 41-2622, does hereby resolve to levy and collect a biennial occupation or license tax from the licensee in the amount of Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$500.00).


WHEREAS, this Resolution is passed, approved and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas on the date and year first above written.


