

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A "35 MPH SPEED LIMIT" SIGN ON JACKSON COUNTY ROAD "270"

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2008, local authorities may erect and maintain signs for roads under their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that in the best interest of the traveling public that A "35 mph speed limit sign" be required at the following described county road or highway location, to wit:

Also, described as to establish a speed zone starting on County Road "270" between "E" road and "I" road , a distance of approximately four miles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JACKSON COUNTY, KANSAS that signs be erected and maintained and the same is hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe traffic control for the above described location. This resolution shall become effective when the appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon the road above described.


