

RESOLUTION NO. 2013- 11

A Resolution changing the policy and agreement to improve an unimproved county road way

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas, meeting in a regular session on this 15th day of April, 2013, does hereby resolve as follows, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas has previously adopted a policy whereby anyone who wants to improve an unimproved road way is responsible for paying all costs associated with restoration of an abandoned road.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas, does hereby resolve as follows, to-wit:

"If the unimproved road has been abandoned and it is currently not being used, there will have to be a determination of Jackson County's interest in restoring the road. The person or persons requesting the same shall pay all costs associated with the restoration of an abandoned road. There will be negotiations of whether the County or a private contractor will perform the actual work to Jackson County and/or State of Kansas standards. The determination will be made depending upon the current condition of the right of way. After this request is made, a representative of Jackson County will submit an estimate of the project's cost. One hundred percent (100%) of the cost will be due before work will proceed. It is emphasized that this will be an estimate and actual cost could exceed what is estimated. The remaining balance is due immediately upon completion."


WHEREAS, this Resolution is passed, approved and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas on the date and year first above written.


