**A Resolution establishing new rates for Jackson County residents using the
Jackson County Landfill**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JACKSON COUNTY, KANSAS on this 23rd day of March, 2015, by their authority for the promotion of health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Jackson County, Kansas that new rates are hereby established effective July 1, 2015 for Jackson County residents using the Jackson County Landfill.

The new landfill rates adopted by Jackson County, Kansas are as follows, to-wit:

RATES FOR JACKSON COUNTY LANDFILL

JACKSON COUNTY RESIDENTS

CAR ----- \$10.00 per load
SMALL PICKUPS (FULL - LEVEL BED) ----- \$14.00 per load
REGULAR PICKUPS (FULL - LEVEL BED) ----- \$20.00 & up per load
LARGER TRUCKS (FULL - LEVEL BED) ----- \$10.00 per cubic yard

**BUMPER PULL AND GOOSENECK TRAILERS AND LARGE TRUCKS
SHALL BE CALCULATED BY THE CUBIC YARD OF MATERIALS HAULED**

APPLIANCES ----- \$1.00
TIRES (regular passenger car or compact truck) -- \$2.00
MEDIUM TRUCK TIRES (under 10.00-20) ----- \$5.00
LARGE TRUCK TIRES (over 10.00-20) ----- \$8.00
FARM/TRACTOR REAR ----- \$15.00
SMALL OTR and combine (up to 17.5-25) ----- \$25.00
LARGE OTR and combine (up to 23.5-25) ----- \$50.00
ROAD GRADER ----- \$50.00

TIRE RIMS WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE

**TRUCKS AND TRAILERS LESS THAN FULL WILL BE CALCULATED
BY THE CUBIC YARD OR MATERIALS HAULED**

UNSECURED LOADS WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE

**NO ITEMS CONTAINING FREON WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS THE
OWNER/Hauler CAN SHOW PROPER PROOF OF PROPER REMOVAL**

NO OUT OF COUNTY TRASH OR REFUSE WILL BE ACCEPTED

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the hours of operation of the landfill shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, Friday and Saturday of each week.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any rates and regulations pertaining to the Jackson County Landfill that are inconsistent with this Resolution shall be deemed repealed and of no force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above provisions are hereby adopted on the day and year first above written by the Board of County Commissioners of Jackson County, Kansas, and this Resolution shall go into force and become effective upon publication in the official county newspaper. The new rates will go into effect starting July 1, 2015.
