

REAL-ID FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: When do I have to be Real ID Compliant?

A: By May 3, 2023, a Real ID compliant driver's license or identification card will be required to board a domestic flight or enter designated federal facilities

A current non-real ID Kansas license or ID will continue work to board a domestic flight or enter a designated federal facility through May 2, 2023. You have the option of adding the Real-ID during your renewal for no extra fee; or if your license or ID expires after May 2, 2023, you may add it at any time for \$13.00

Q: What do I need to bring in to obtain a Real ID drivers' license or identification card?

A: Certified birth certificate or unexpired US passport

Social Security Card

Proof of name change if using a birth certificate or passport and the name is different than the current driver's license or identification card. Examples are Marriage license, Divorce decree, Court order of Adoption, or Court Order of name change.

Proof of residency, must be physical address and NOT a Post Office Box.

Q: What does the Real ID indicator look like?

A: A Real ID compliant driver's license or identification card will have a Gold Circle with a star located in the upper right corner

Q: What if I do not bring in the required documentation?

A: You will be issued a Non-Real ID compliant driver's license or identification card which has the words "Not For Federal ID" printed on the card

Q: What does it cost to obtain a Real ID compliant driver's license or identification card?

A: If it is time of renewal regular renewal fees will apply If it is prior to the renewal date and ONLY the Real ID indicator is being added it is \$13.00

Q: Will the Real ID indicator be printed on a Conceal and Carry license?

A: No

Q: Will the Real ID indicator be printed on the temporary license?

A: No
