Unified School District No. 3 35

Sales Tax Question Submitted

Shall Jackson County, Kansas be authorized to impose a one-quarter percent (0.25%) countywide retailers' sales tax, the proceeds of which will be used to support hospital services in Jackson County, Kansas by Rural Health Resources of Jackson Co., Inc. doing business as Holton Community Hospital to which such proceeds shall be paid. The collection of such sales tax will commence on January 1, 2026, and terminate ten (10) years thereafter, all pursuant to
